### Divisions

**Pee Wee:** Ages 2 - 6 yrs

**Junior:** Ages 11 - 13 yrs

**Youth:** Ages 7 - 10 yrs

**Senior:** Ages 14 - 18 yrs

\*\* Age is based on the contestant's age as of Jan 1st 2021

### Awards

Both boys and girls will compete together for money payout in each event, however, they will be awarded points separately for All-Around awards.

**All-Around Saddles:** 6 saddles will be awarded to the high point all-around winner in each age group (with the exception of Pee Wee).

**Ties will be decided by most money won.**

1. Senior Boy 2. Senior Girl 3. Junior Boy 4. Junior Girl 5. Youth Boy 6. Youth Girl

**All-Around Awards:** Prizes will be awarded to Reserve All-Around, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> place in each age group (with the exception of Pee Wee).

**Ties will be decided by most money won.**

1. Senior Boy 2. Senior Girl 3. Junior Boy 4. Junior Girl 5. Youth Boy 6. Youth Girl

**Pee Wee Awards:** Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 in each Pee Wee event.

\* No All-Around prizes.

\*\* *Must be present to receive awards*

### **Payouts: 60% PAYBACK**

1-4 entries = 1 money      5-9 entries = 2 monies      10-14 entries = 3 monies  
15-20 entries = 4 monies      21-29 entries = 5 monies      Over 30 entries = 6 monies

### **Points:**

Points will be awarded for 1st - 9th place in each event. Points will be kept in each age group and gender.

1 <sup>st</sup> = 10pts	4 <sup>th</sup> = 6pts	7 <sup>th</sup> = 3pts
2 <sup>nd</sup> = 8pts	5 <sup>th</sup> = 5pts	8 <sup>th</sup> = 2pts
3 <sup>rd</sup> = 7pts	6 <sup>th</sup> = 4pts	9 <sup>th</sup> = 1pt

## Rules & Regulations

NHSRA Rules will be utilized by the Middletown Junior Rodeo Committee and Judges will make the final determination.

1. All contestants shall comply with the rules. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will result in DISQUALIFICATION.
2. As of January 1, 2021, you must be no older than 18 years of age. All contestants must provide proof of age with entry (copy of birth certificate).
3. No entry will be accepted unless signed by a **Parent or Guardian**.
4. All contestants must wear western attire. (western boots, western trousers, long sleeve wrist length shirt with collar and cuffs, and western hat or helmet)
5. Any adult helping in the arena and/or behind the bucking chutes **MUST** be in western attire. (western boots, western trousers, long sleeve wrist length shirt with collar and cuffs, and western hat or helmet)
6. \$5 fine for losing hat during competition in the arena.
7. Drug or alcohol use by a contestant will result in automatic DISQUALIFICATION. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages in the arena (adults).
8. Contestant's name will be called 3 times. If not present on the third call, you are DISQUALIFIED & TURNOUT in that event. No refund or substitutes for Turnouts. (Medical releases will be at the discretion of the Arena Director and Committee).
9. Pee Wee event contestants will be disqualified if they don't have stirrups that fit them (i.e. parent's saddles) due to safety concerns. They must have control of their horses. If the Arena Director thinks the saddle or a horse pose a safety issue the Pee Wee contestant may be unable to participate in the mounted event.

### Grievance Procedure

- Contestants must **ONLY** address all questions or problems to the Arena Director. Parents or other interested person who gets involved with the event director, judges, or other rodeo official, runs the risk of having the person whom they are trying to assist DISQUALIFIED.
- No one is allowed in the arena **unless an official of the rodeo or granted by the Arena Director**.

### Events Rules

**Time Limit:** 30 second time limit for all events with the exception of Youth & Pee Wee who will have a 60 second time limit for each event.

**Steer Daubing:** Horse must be backed into the box prior to calling for your steer. After daubing the steer contestant must raise the dauber to get a flag.

**Calf/Steer Riding:** Must ride 6 seconds to get a score.

**Calf/Steer/Bull Riding:** PROTECTIVE VEST IS MANDATORY!!! If no qualified ride, no points or money will be awarded.

**Team Roping:** 3 loops. Confirm with partner, both entries must be received. You are responsible for finding a partner.

**Hide Race:** Youth **MUST** have an adult puller. Juniors & Seniors - Puller must be someone from your own division or an adult. Confirm with partner, both entries must be received. You are responsible for finding a partner.

**Dummy Roping:** 90 second time limit for each roper. Officials will count legal head catches. Top 6 ropers with the greatest number of catches will return for the short-go. **SHORT-GO:** Each will rope again for 90 seconds to determine the winner.

**Pee Wee Single Stake:** If your horse is on lead line you will place behind the Pee Wees that run with no assistance.
